2020 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Yarra Hills Secondary College offers a range of scholarships in the following areas:

Academic

Academic Scholarships are awarded to students who have displayed outstanding academic success at Primary School and in the educational testing conducted at Yarra Hills Secondary College for all short-listed applicants. Parents please note that there is a cost of \$40 for all short-listed applicants who sit the educational testing.

Leadership

Leadership Scholarships are awarded to students who exhibit a comprehensive range of leadership skills though out their time at Primary school. Applicants should demonstrate their skills of leadership and how they utilised those skills to make a difference within the community.

Arts

Arts scholarships are awarded to students who have displayed exceptional aptitude in either a range of visual or performing arts areas (Music, Drama/ Acting, Singing, Dance). Applicants should have a folio of work they have completed or had involvement in.

Sporting

Sporting Scholarships are awarded to students who have been involved in a range of sporting activities at Primary School and in the community. Applicants should demonstrate outstanding sporting talents such as the attributes of fairness, cooperation and leadership.

**All successful applicants will be awarded:
A school credit of up to \$500 to go towards
school fees, books or laptop.**

SELECTION

Selection for all Scholarships is based on the full written application and primary school reference as well as an interview (and in the case of an Academic Scholarship, results from the educational testing will also be taken into consideration, though not used as the sole deciding factor on success). You should also include a current school report and Primary School reference sheet to support your application. Scholarships are awarded for one year only.

APPLICATION

Please fill out and return the attached Preliminary Application Form to the College (either during our Information Evening, or via post prior to the closing date). After the closing date, all students who have expressed interest will be mailed out a full set of application forms. The full scholarship application must be completed and returned to the College no later than Friday 28 June 2019. Applicants for the Academic Scholarship must sit the educational testing during the allocated interview time (which will be provided once applicants have been short-listed). There will be a cost to the parent of \$40 to contribute to the cost of this testing.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Applicants for all scholarships must have excellent academic and behavioural record. In addition to Scholarship specific requirements, all applicants must be able to demonstrate at interview and by written application that they possess personal qualities and values which will contribute significantly to our College.

The College will only award scholarships if the applicant is of the highest standard.

Parents/Carers need to understand that it is not possible to award a scholarship to every worthy applicant and will abide by the final decision of the College personnel.

The College Campus Assistant Principals will closely monitor all scholarship recipients. Poor performance by a Scholarship recipient may result in a scholarship being revoked.

All applicants will be notified of the result of their application by letter and will abide by the decision of the College. Late applications cannot be accepted by the College.
