

### Multi-Campus Structure

Yarra Hills Secondary College is a multi-campus Year 7-12 college in the outer eastern suburbs of Melbourne, with campuses in Mooroolbark and Mt Evelyn.

The Mt Evelyn Campus is an entrenched part of the Mt Evelyn community and services the areas from Mt Evelyn through the Yarra Valley and all the way to Warburton. The Mooroolbark Campus is situated amongst the suburbs of Mooroolbark, Lilydale, Croydon and Kilsyth, serving these and surrounding areas. Greater community interest in recent years has led to increased enrolments across the college at all year levels.

Both Junior Schools provide an extensive and comprehensive curriculum, building strong foundations and providing a rich selection of elective offerings. With a Common Instructional Model in place across both campuses, we can ensure that all students are receiving the highest quality education and instructional practices. Our Literacy and Numeracy Learning Specialist teachers also support staff and students to achieve the best student outcomes.

We are also widely recognised for our co-curricular programs, with students able to participate in a number of areas, such as the College Production, Yarra Hills Community Art Show, Instrumental Music Program, Sports, Outdoor Education and Camps. These programs create opportunities for all students and allow them to develop their talents, both within and outside of the core curriculum.

#### Looking After Your Child

Yarra Hills Secondary College caters for a large catchment of students and prides itself on striving to meet the educational and wellbeing needs of those in its community. In line with our commitment to the college values, Respect, Endeavour, Achievement and Pride, a 'Life Skills' Program runs across Years 7 - 10. Taught once a week, this program focuses on one of these values each term. Through working in partnership with students and their families, Yarra Hills seeks to support the growth and development of the whole student in preparation for their senior studies. As our students transition into the senior school. we continue to build upon their educational and wellbeing needs with our 'ASPIRE' program, which focuses on supporting them during their final years of school, guiding them through the demands of VCE.

Positive and respectful relationships play a central part in the college and these are formed in an environment that is safe, engaging and inclusive of everyone. The College 'Code of Conduct' sets out high expectations of staff, students and the wider school community to support the best student learning outcomes.

A wide range of wellbeing supports are available within the college with a dedicated wellbeing team that support both staff and students. Yarra Hills Secondary College is also part of the 'Doctor in Secondary Schools Program', which provides students with access to a general practitioner. Students also have access to the school nurse, who works on site to support adolescent health and development.

#### Student Opportunities

The College House system unites students across all age groups as they compete against each other in the annual swimming carnival, cross-country and athletics. Students experience terrific team spirit through being attached to one of four Houses: w (Red), Dolphins (Blue), Dragons (Green) and Eagles (Gold).

College awards, camps, student leadership programs and co-curricular activities all seek to enrich the lives of students at Yarra Hills Secondary College, while they are encouraged to build a sense of community.

#### Learning Journey

Yarra Hills Secondary College works closely with all of our feeder primary schools to ensure a smooth and informed transition for students and parents as they enter the next stage of the educational journey.

Our transition program is designed to ensure your child feels ready and prepared for secondary school life, we focus on knowing your child and their academic strengths and weaknesses and we build positive relationships with the students to ensure their transition is as smooth as possible.

A team of teachers work with the students in each Home Group to plan engaging and challenging programs. Staff use a range of data sources including literacy, numeracy and engagement data to improve student outcomes. We pride ourselves on delivering a differentiated High Abilities extension program and literacy and numeracy learning support. Our key strength is that we really know our students. This helps us to create an environment where your child feels like they truly belong.

As students near the end of Year 10 and are looking towards their Senior Studies in Years 11 and 12, a dedicated Careers & Pathways team provide information evenings and course counselling. Yarra Hills Secondary College ensures all students choose the best course, and ultimately career pathway, which meets student's passions and interests, guiding them into their futures.

#### Home Study

Homework is a very important feature of the Yarra Hills Secondary College Curriculum. It encourages development of organisational skills and positive home study habits as well as parent participation in the learning process. Homework also provides additional learning time for:

- Revision of previously learned work
- Reinforcement of skills and techniques
  developed at school
- Preparation for in-school learning
- Research to support and/or enhance in-school learning
- Completing work missed due to absence.
