Things to look out for:

- **Partial completion** -- If a course states it is partial completion it means that students will not complete the full Certificate at the end of the program with school VET. Generally, there will be alternative opportunities for them to complete the Cert outside of school.
- **Full completion** – students will receive the Cert II or III qualification at the end of the course
- **Check Subject outline** – Look at the subject (unit) taught within the course to help decide if this course is right for you.
- **Restrictions** – VET program for year 10 or VCE (Yr11 & 12) students can only do VET scheduled on a Wednesday afternoon.
- **Eligibility**- VET is a selective program for year 10 students (year 9 going into year 10 for 2026)
- **Travel** – Student will need to commute to and from the VET provider so ensure it is a place you can travel to every week.
- **How to apply** - for VET see end of Brochure.

How to Apply

If you are interested in taking VET in 2026, please follow the steps:

- 1) Complete the VET EOI (expression of Interest) form base on your correct year level:
 - **Current Year 10 students** VET EOI form: <https://forms.office.com/r/mQFEgAvs28>
 - **Current Year 9 students** VET EOI form: <https://forms.office.com/r/YbQ076JNkz>
- 2) Ensure VET is selected as part of your school subject selection for 2026 – (course counselling / Edval subject selection etc.)
- 3) You will be notified about the outcome of your VET application later this term and there will be more documentation to complete from the VET providers.

*** VET is a selective process for students in year 9 wanting to do VET during year 10 – please read the selection criteria before applying for VET.
