Year 9 transition: VET 2026 – criteria and process for application

Criteria for enrolment:

1. Year 9 attendance-to-date no lower than 80%
2. Academic performance and levels need to be suitable for success in a VET course
3. Behaviour and conduct –
 - a. Students must have a good record of timeliness to school and to classes. Students with a discernible habit or pattern of lateness do not meet these criteria.
 - b. Work Habits (noted in Semester reports) need to be of a suitable level overall to ensure success in a VET course (see Work habits – Effort, Class behaviour, Completion).
4. Complete an (online) Expression Of Interest for enrolment.

A note on VET course costs.

VET course cost from \$1500 to \$3000 per certificate and can include equipment and material costs. These costs are covered in combination by the VET Delivered to School Students (VDSS) and the college. These costs are incurred upon enrolment – if students discontinue or do not attend these costs are still incurred.

Process for enrolment

1. Complete the online Expression of Interest form:

 - a. Student eligibility checked. Ineligible students are informed of this
2. If approved for enrolment, families receive and complete a VET Enrolment Form (paper), requiring school, parent, and student sign-off
3. Families complete the Course Enrolment Form from the TAFE/education provider
